Community Council Meeting was held on Wednesday 23rd of October 2013 at 7.30 pm at Canolfan Bro Cernyw

Apologies : Gwydion Jones , Elen Haf Edwards , Ifor Edwards , Tecwyn Evans

Present : Gwyn Williams (Chair ) , Ann Vaughan , Diane Roberts , Gwynfor Davies , Ian Griffith , Emlyn Williams , Cllr Dilwyn O Roberts & Clerk .

The Chairman welcomed everyone to the meeting and welcomed PCSO Ray Elliott of Llanrwst who works with Dan Owen in our area . He was thanked for attending the meeting.

17.1 DECLARATION - members were given the opportunity to declare a connection with an item on the Agenda .

17.2 MINUTES - The minutes of the meeting of September 25th were accepted as a true record.

17.3 PLANNING APPLICATIONS – A planning application was received after the Agenda was sent out and the Clerk sent this information to members via email and placed an addendum to the Agenda in the villages .

17.4 IVY ON CEMETERY WALL - the ivy was on part of the wall owned by the Church and part of the wall owned by the Community Council. RESOLVED to observe the situation . The Clerk had mentioned this to officials of St Digain Church.

17.5 BOUNDARY REVIEW OF COMMUNITY COUNCILS IN CONWY - according to the review Pandy Tudur would lose one councilor. RESOLVED to forward the following comments :

- a) to note that the details on Pandy Tudur were wrong and that there was no vacancy in the ward
- b ) that the ward is very rural and therefore it is far to travel from one end to the other - small percentage of the population living in the village and most live outside
- c ) the population of the Council area is very close to 1000 which justified having 11 councilors
- d ) work of councilors is entirely voluntary - no one claims any expenses. It does not cost more to have 11 councilors rather than 10 .

17.6 THE PILGRIM'S PATH PROJECT – it is understood that Conwy County officials are looking into the developments . RESOLVED to invite Suryiah Evans to the next meeting to hear about the latest developments and to invite officers from Conwy , such as Elen Edwards or Ann Lloyd Williams .

#### 17.7 PLANNING APPLICATIONS

17.7.1 APPLICATION NUMBER 0 / 40 172 Erection of extension over a fish pond Tan y Ffordd , Llangernyw by Mrs. Karen Johnson . RESOLVED to object for the following reasons :

- a) the extension does not fit in with the other houses in the area
- b ) the building looks very big

c) shouldn't the fish be outside and not indoors?

17.7.2 APPLICATION No. 0 / 40207 Refurbishment and extension of slurry tank in existing cattle shed on land near Ty Mawr Gell , Llangernyw by Mr Edwin Noble .  
RESOLVED to support the application .

17.8 FINANCIAL APPLICATIONS - RESOLVED to contribute £ 40 towards the Urdd Conwy but not contribute to the National Eisteddfod of Wales Carmarthenshire 2014 nor Children's Therapy Centre Wales.

#### 17.9 REPORTS OF MEETINGS

17.9.1 ANNUAL MEETING ONE VOICE WALES - there was a report of the Meeting and Conference in Builth Wells by the Chairman . There had been various talks, among them members of the National Planning Department , and youth worker and a commissioner . The feeling was that very low representation from the north was present . Also all the proposals came from the South . RESOLVED to write to OVW to express this and to ask when the Conference was held in the North last and asked if they could attract more delegates from the North .

17.9.2 LOCAL COMMITTEE ONE VOICE WALES - there was a report from the meeting by Diane Roberts . It wasn't a long meeting and the next meeting will be on January 22 .

17.9.3 COMMUNITY AND TOWN COUNCILS CONWY FORUM - Clerk and Chairman attended the meeting at Bodlondeb and the Clerk attended the meeting for the Clerks an hour earlier. At the meeting the chairperson referred to online forms on Conwy website which members of the public use to send a complaint , compliment or comment to the Council ; a revised Customer Service Standards Charter needed any comments before 29th of November; there was a presentation by Anna Humphreys Office of the Police Commissioner in the absence of the Deputy Commissioner . The next meeting is on 20 January.

17.9.4 CODE OF CONDUCT COURSE - The Chairman attended the course in Llanrwst - course was very beneficial . Course notes were received and RESOLVED to send them to members via e - mail . New document by the Ombudsman will also be sent out to members.

17:10 FLOOD MONEY FROM ST ASAPH - discussed how to spend the £ 100 received following a concert held in St Asaph . RESOLVED to think more about it and discuss it next time.

17:11 TOURISM SIGN TO IDENTIFY THE ANCIENT YEW LLANGERNYW - received a letter giving permission for visitors to park in the car park of the Old Stag Hotel in the village which would help towards making the application for a sign . RESOLVED to ask Conwy Council if there would be permission to place a sign and ask whether a grant is available from the Rural Development Plan .
