Wedi cyrraedd Trefelin a threulio amser yno buont yn teithio ar draws y paith i Drelew a'r Gaiman – taith o 8 awr ar y bws. Roedd yn sych iawn yno a buont yn cymryd rhan yn Eisteddfod Chubut 2013. Community Council's Annual General Meeting was held Wednesday, May 21st 2014 at 7.30 pm at Pandy Tudur

Present: Gwyn Williams (Chair), Diane Roberts, Tecwyn Evans, Ann Vaughan, Gwynfor Davies, Emlyn Williams, Ifor Edwards and the Clerk.

One member of the public was present.

26.1 TALK BY Erin Gwyn Rossington - Erin welcomed to the meeting by the Chairman. Erin received a grant from the Council towards her educational trip to Patagonia with the Urdd in October. Arrived Trefelin and after spending time there they traveled across the prairie to Trelew and Gaiman - a journey of 8 hours on the bus. It was very dry there and Erin took part in Chubut Eisteddfod 2013. She enjoyed the welcome and the experience very much and especially participating and being successful in the Eisteddfod. He enjoyed the meal 'asaddo' too. Erin was thanked for his interesting talk.

26.2 DECLARATION - gave members the opportunity to declare a connection with an item on the Agenda.

26.3 minutes - of April 30 were accepted as a true record.

26.4 FINANCIAL STATEMENT AND STATEMENT OF GOVERNMENT - statements were received following Mrs Gwenda Cooper examined the books. The statement was signed by the Chairman.

26.5 CHAIRMAN'S REPORT

Gwyn Williams thanked the members for attending meetings throughout the year and do so much volunteer work on behalf of the area. He thanked the Clerk for her work. He referred to incidents during the past year - the Pilgrim's Trail, the hope of reopening the Llangernyw toilets, the possibility of losing one seat in Pandy Tudur ward. Attended One Voice Wales Conference in Builth Wells but was disappointed how low the representation from North Wales there. He went to a site meeting and Llys Dymper Planning Committee meeting to discuss the planning application in Conwy. He attended meetings of the Conwy Town and Community Councils Forum and seen low attendance from rural areas. The Chairman thanked everyone for their support during the year.

26.6 ELECTION OF CHAIRMAN - Elen Haf Edwards was elected as Chairman of the Council but apologized that she could not be present. Gwyn Williams stayed in the chair for the remainder of the meeting.

26.7 VICE CHAIR - Gwynfor Davies was elected as Vice-Chairman.

26.8 SUB-COMMITTEES COMMUNITY COUNCIL - RESOLVED that members of the Sub-committees remain the same again this year.

26.9 REPRESENTATIVES ON COMMITTEES IN THE COMMUNITY - RESOLVED members staying on the committee: Museum - Elen H Edwards (Chair); Canolfan Bro Cernyw - Ian Griffith and Gerwyn Davies, One Voice Area Committee - Diane Roberts, Tecwyn Evans.

26.10 ROADS AND ENVIRONMENTAL ISSUES

There were obstacles on the path at Tyn y Caeau and need to look at Hafodunos path. RESOLVED Kevin Roberts asked if he could look at Pont Faen path and stile has disappeared. It was proposed to ask Llangernyw walking group if they were interested in walking the long walk. It was felt that the walking leaflet could be relaunched in the meeting in the Museum on 5th July, but need to ensure the paths are open.

26.11 CLERK SALARY - Diane Roberts shared information to members and will be discussed next time.

26.12 GRANT APPLICATION – Ysgol Bro Cernyw has applied for a contribution towards the cost of going to the Eisteddfod in Bala. RESOLVED to donate £ 300 from Bro Cernyw Fund.

26.13 CHANGE NAME TO CVSC - the answer to our complaint that the Welsh name has disappeared from the logo tells they did a research and discussion and see that they are not known by the acronym CGGC as that this is linked to Wales

Council Voluntary Action. RESOLVED to answer the letter by saying that we are disappointed and ask where the research was made and with which members.

26.14 SLCC AND ONE VOICE WALES TRAINING SEMINAR - The Clerk attended the seminar at Venue Cymru on May 15th. Presentations were made by the Chief Executive of Wrexham Council, Councils Insurance Company, Huw Vaughan Thomas (Wales Auditor) and smaller workshops in the afternoon.

26.15 ONE VOICE AND I.C.O. COURSE - Diane Roberts expressed interest in attending the course on 25th September, Mold. Need to ask One Voice why they could not arrange a course that was more central to its members eg Glasdir, Llanrwst.

26.16 CONSULTANCY SERVICES ONE VOICE - received a document stating that the advisory services available.

26.17 OTHER MATTERS

26.17.1 Need to look at Llangernyw Cemetery tap again.

26.17.2 Siwgr & Sbeis Rhian Williams congratulated on their success in winning the Conwy Business Award.

26.17.2 Embankment is broken down and the land has been fenced closer to the highway - need to contact the Department of Highways and Planning. Photographs are available as evidence.

26.17.3 Conwy and Dee Presbytery have welcomed the change for Gwytherin Chapel Cemetery to come into the care of the Community Council.

26.17.4 decided to send a letter to the owner of Gwytherin Church to make sure that the grass cutter crossing to the Glebe go along the wall and not over graves.

26.17.5 Grass overgrown by the river at Gwytherin playground and very dangerous for children.
