Mr Tecwyn Evans was welcomed back following illness.

54.1 DECLARATION - members were given the opportunity to declare a connection with an item on the agenda.

54.2 MINUTES - looked at minutes of April 20 and May 11 2016 meetings and RESOLVED unanimously for them to be accepted as a correct record.

54.3 ISSUES ARISING

54.3.1 LLANGERNYW TIDYING UP - had a successful morning on May 14th, but unfortunately brushes and tins of paint were found thrown behind the toilets

54.3.2 COUNCIL WEBSITE - The Clerk to send a card of condolence to Mr Arfon Parry following the passing of his mother.

54.3.3 COMMUNITY SKIPS - some problems arised following delivery of skips eg Asbestos had been left in Pandy Tudur. RESOLVED to discuss the matter in detail before ordering skips next year.

54.3.4 PONT RHYDLECHOG - discussed the possibility of installing a bridge but RESOLVED to leave for now.

54.4 CHAIRMAN'S REPORT – looking back over the year the Chairman D Gwynfor Davies pointed out that we live in a busy area and there are many planning applications to be discussed - both business and residential. One application has contravened our opinion, namely Pen y Bryn, Trofarth wind turbines. Llangernyw Public Toilets have been opened after years of being closed. He thanked the Aelwyd for painting bus stops and the Gardening Club for planting flowers. Two bridges are closed in the area at the moment, which causes difficulties for users and local residents. The Chairman thanked the members for their support during the year and to members of the public for their input. He thanked the Clerk and everyone who has worked for the Council. He felt some uncertainty ahead with the European referendum. He expressed thanks for the opportunity to be the Chairman of the Council over the year.

54.5 ELECTION OF CHAIR - Gwydion A Jones was elected Chairman of the Council. Gwydion Jones became the chair and thanked the Past Chairman for his work throughout the year.

54.6 ELECTION OF VICE CHAIR - Gwyn Williams was nominated as Vice-Chairman.

54.7 COMMUNITY COUNCIL SUB COMMITTEES - RESOLVED unanimously that the membership of the Sub-Committees will remain the same this year but that there was a right to co-opt members.

54.9 ROAD ISSUES AND ENVIRONMENT

54.9.1 PROHIBITION OF ENTRY – BRON GELLI HILL, PANDY TUDUR

A letter from the Traffic Department is asking for our opinion on banning traffic from travelling up Bron Gelli hill because of the risk of joining the top road. RESOLVED unanimously to support the application.

54.9.2 PLACING A MIRROR NEAR PARC AELAS, LLANGERNYW AND NEAR THE STAG - the Department of Environment to look at the problem of vision and excessive growth but they did not see the mirrors would likely be granted by the Welsh Government due to change of policy.

54.9.3 SITE MEETING WITH MR DAVID JONES MP - had a meeting on Friday afternoon May 20 to discuss the consequences of the closure of the Bridge over River Gall near The Old Vicarage Nursing Home (Present: David Jones MP, Gwynfor Davies, Emlyn Williams, Diane M Roberts, Gwydion Jones, Gwenda Vaughan, Carol Walker and the Clerk and met with the Old Vicarage Home Manager). Mr David Jones sent a letter expressing our concerns to the Chief Executive of Conwy C B Council asking when it would be likely that the work would be done on the bridge.

54.10 PLANNING MATTERS

54.10.1 Application No. 0/42770 Extension and proposed changes in Coed Bedw, Pandy Tudur by Mr & Mrs Hamer - RESOLVED unanimously to support the application.

54.10.2 Application No. 0/42773 1) Conversion of existing garage outbuilding to dwelling (use class C3) to be used as a holiday home 2) Build a greenhouse (partly retrospective) 3) Construct a

in kitchen connection with dining area outside 4) use part curtilage garden outside for class A3 use in Meirion Stores & PO, Llangernyw by Mr & Mrs D Baines - RESOLVED unanimously to support the application.

54.10.3 Application No. 0/42782 Variation of condition No. 7, deleting conditions 13, 14 and 15 of planning permission 0/38105 (Building 1 dwelling (renewal of planning permission granted under code ref: 0/31827) on land near Y Graig, Llangernyw by Mr I Hughes - RESOLVED unanimously to support the application.

54.11 LLANGERNYW TOILET - Ann Vaughan reported on the latest developments. Mr Gwynfor Davies, Swyn y Nant is opening the door in the morning and Mr. Dylan Baines, Village Shop is closing around 6.30pm. It needed a sign 'Disabled', needed a bin with a lid on it, and a temporary sign to show TOILETS site. Ann Vaughan offered to contact Conwy about this. The Clerk was given a spare key to the toilets.

54.12 ONE VOICE REGIONAL COMMITTEE - there was a report of the Meeting held on April 13 by Diane M Roberts. There were speakers on 'Defibrillator' during the meeting. There will be vote at the Annual Meeting on October 1 on the change into a company by guarantee and needed 120 members there to vote. There was discussion on the new External Auditors - asking why the appointment of the company outside of Wales and raising costs. Also emphasized the need for all councilors to attend future training. Diane Roberts was thanked for her report. Referred to the defibrillator which will be installed in Llangernyw and the costs of its installation.

54.13 LOCAL ISSUES

54.13.1 Litter seen in the Garden of Remembrance - need to be monitored.

54.13.2 Need more dog bins in Llangernyw - near Bridge Inn and near Pont Faen.

54.13.3 There was a feeling of disappointment that nothing has been done on the bridge near Vicarage or improvements to passing places etc. although a meeting had been held approx three weeks ago. DIVERSION signs need replacing, some have fallen and there is no indication of Diversion in Glan Rhyd when coming from the side of Llanrwst. RESOLVED to contact Councillor Dilwyn Roberts about this too.

54.13.4 Bad workmanship has been done by Conwy Council on the fence 'Bron Heulog', Llanfair TH - pieces of it falling off.

54.13.5 Received a thank you letter from Merched y Wawr Llangernyw for a contribution from Cronfa Bro Cernyw

54.13.6 Decided to invite Darren Millar AM to a meeting at the end of July.

54.13.7 Pandy Tudur telephone kiosk is damaged - need to contact BT.

54.13.8 Opening session of the Cwm Museum on Saturday, May 28th at 2 pm.
